On Friday 18th October, we observe Anti-Slavery Day which falls within Black History Month and was the theme of this week's Full College Assembly. This is a very important day to raise awareness about the issue of modern slavery and human trafficking, which unfortunately still affect millions of people worldwide, including children and adults. Modern slavery takes many forms, including forced labor, child exploitation, and human trafficking. It is important for us all to understand that even though slavery was abolished many years ago, it still exists in different ways today, often hidden but very real.

A special assembly was held where we watched a short video and heard stories about how young people around the world are taking action against exploitation. Together, we can help spread awareness and fight modern slavery. Let's all be part of the solution!



A workshop was also held which was aimed at raising awareness about modern slavery. This interactive session covered important topics such as:

- The different forms of modern slavery;
- How human trafficking impacts millions of lives globally;
- Ways we can all help combat this issue and raise awareness.

# Daylight Savings SAFETY PLANS...

We are fast approaching winter, clocks are due to go back within the week and the daylight hours are becoming shorter. Students may find themselves travelling to and from college in the hours of darkness over the coming months. Students and their parents, guardians and carers are reminded that in order to maximise their safety on their journeys to and from college we would recommend:

- Where possible students walk/travel in pairs or groups to and from college.
- Walk down main roads/routes that are well lit. Avoid going through parks, alleys or other unlit or poorly lit areas.
- Ensure they are alert to the environment around them, avoid wearing headphones or being distracted by mobile phones and other devices.
- Students should have a set route to and from college that is discussed with parents, guardians and carers.
- Parents, guardians and carers have a personal safety conversation with their children.
- If they are concerned about their safety please call the Police.
