



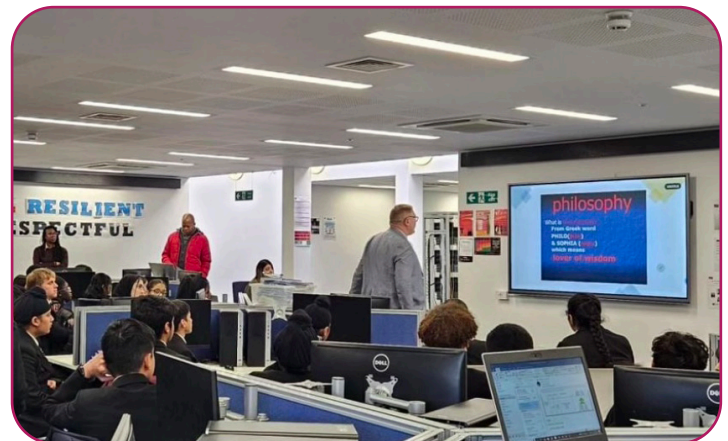
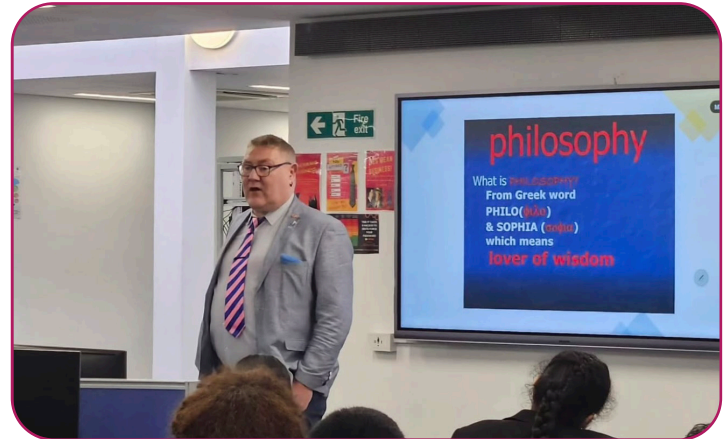
SORTED
