Update on Face Masks

Trial Examinations - Year 11

Trial examinations for all Year 11 students will continue until Friday 10th December. All examinations will take place in the designated room for examinations as per the examination timetable, which was sent home in November. It is of vital importance that each student arrives at college at 8:45am each day, in full college uniform and with the correct equipment. For Science and Mathematics examinations, they must have a calculator, ruler, pencil and a geometry set. Students must also bring a black biro to each examination. Mobile telephones and other electronic devices are NOT PERMITTED to be taken into the examination hall. Therefore, it is requested that students who need to have any such devices with them hand them to the member of staff invigilating at the start of each examination. In the event of illness or an emergency situation that prevents your child attending one or more of the examinations or if they are going to be late, please make contact with the College as soon as possible so that appropriate advice can be given and arrangements put in place. Students will not have study leave during this time, so are expected to attend normal lessons when not in an examination.
