



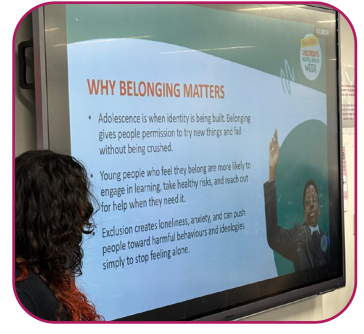
Guest Speaker - Lewis Fogarty
