

## Enrichment Week

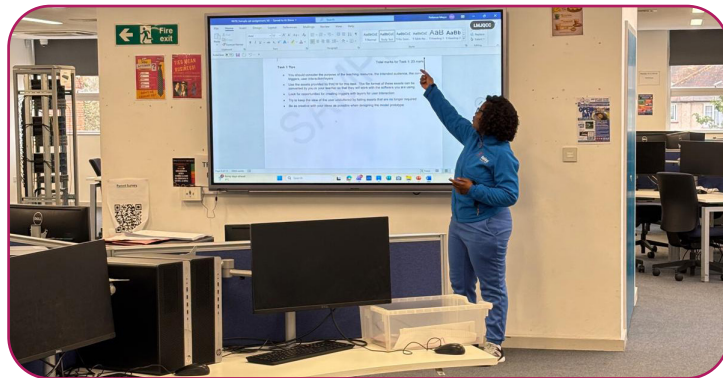
