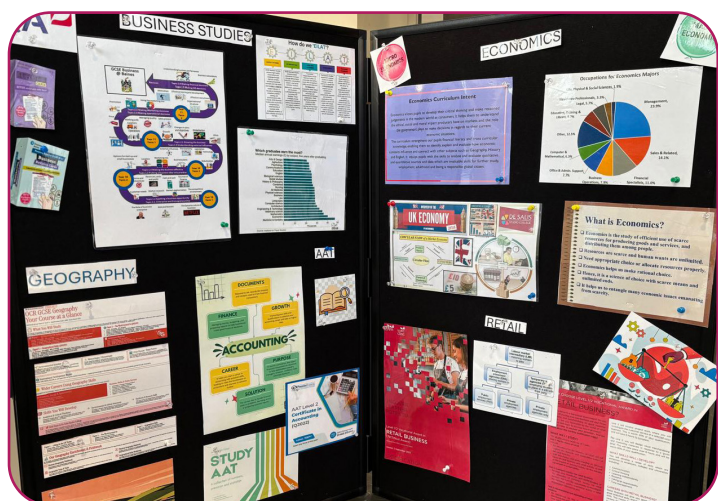
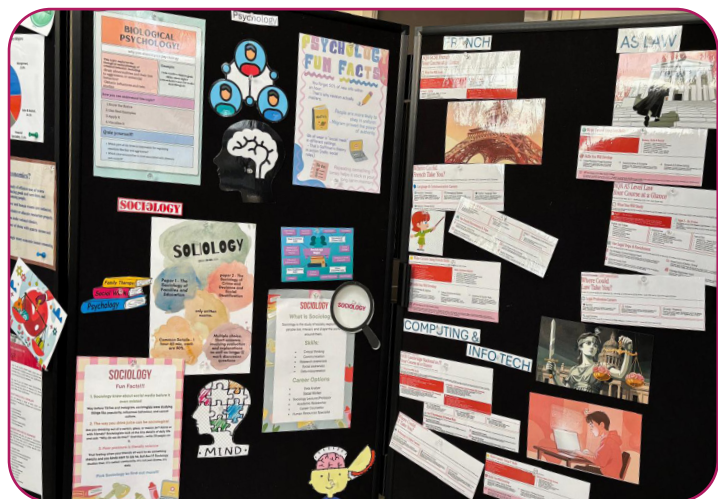


Year 8 Open Evening

French Residential Trip - Pre Trip Meeting

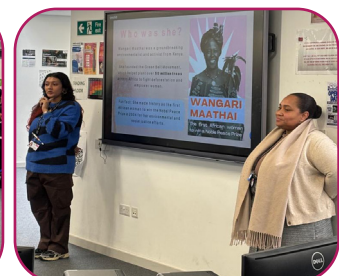

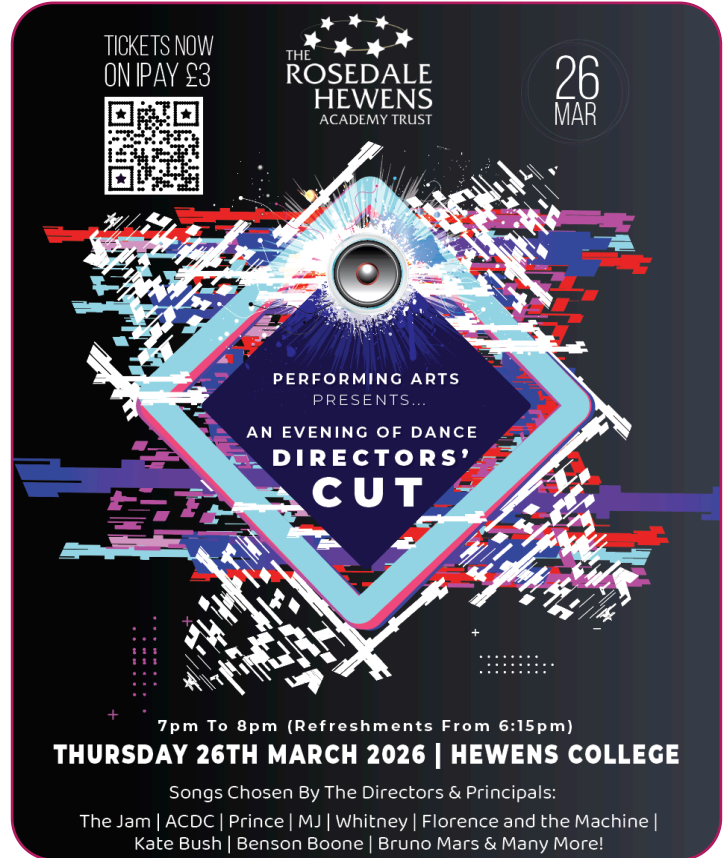
Community Resilience Roadshow
