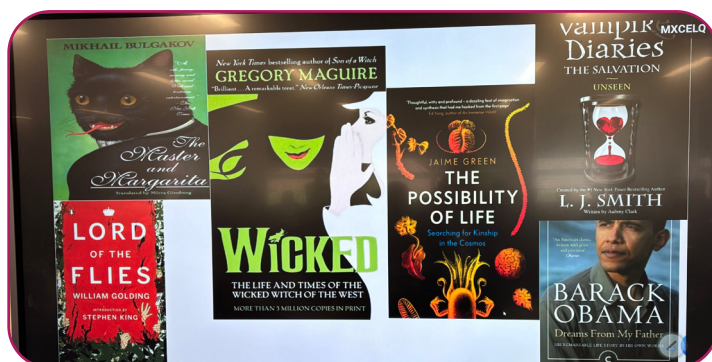

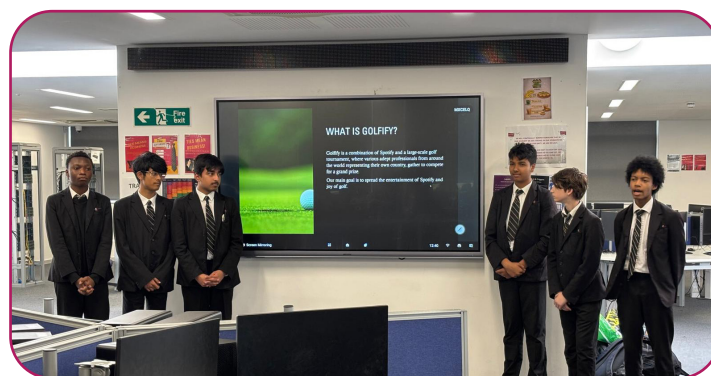
Launch of De Salis Library

The students presented their ideas to the College, demonstrating creativity, confidence and strong presentation skills. The challenge provided students with valuable experience of pitching ideas in a professional setting while developing key employability skills, including teamwork, communication and problem-solving.
