Project Guardian Workshop

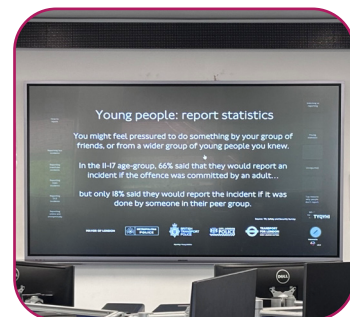
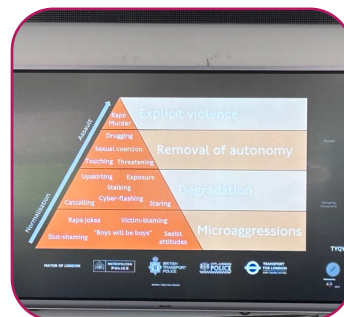


Year 9 and Year 10 students recently took part in Project Guardian workshops, delivered by TfL, focusing on personal safety, awareness and making informed decisions while travelling.

The sessions encouraged students to explore a range of real-life scenarios, helping them to recognise potential risks, understand how to stay safe when using public transport and know where to seek support when needed. Through interactive discussions and practical activities, students developed their understanding of personal responsibility, respectful behaviour and safe travel.

Students also learned about the importance of reporting concerns, looking out for others and making responsible choices when travelling independently. The workshops provided practical advice that students can apply to their everyday journeys, helping to build confidence when using London's transport network.
