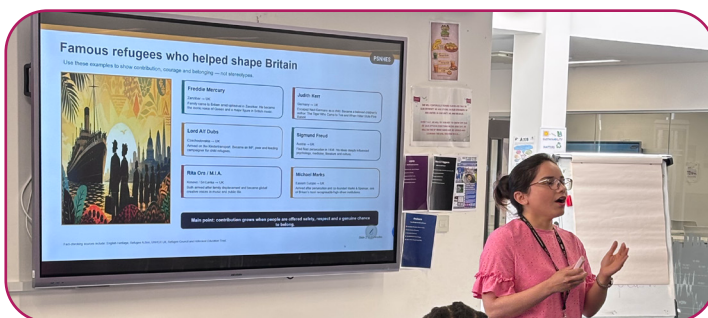
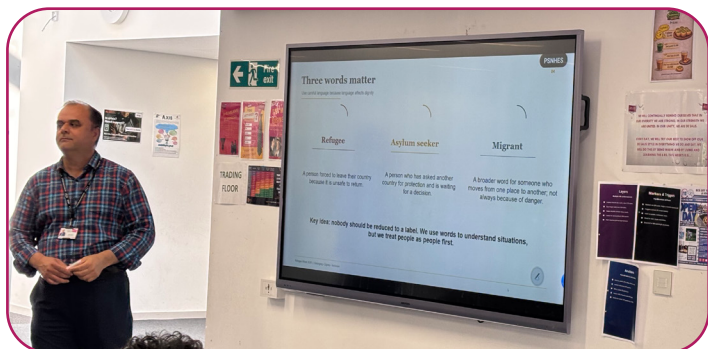
The sessions encouraged open discussion while equipping students with practical strategies to support their emotional wellbeing.

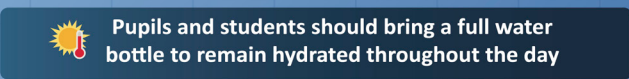


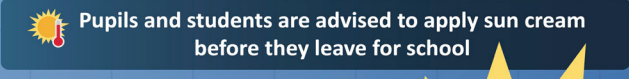
Temperatures in Hayes are forecast to exceed 30°C this week. To support the comfort and wellbeing of all pupils and students, we have implemented the following measures until:
