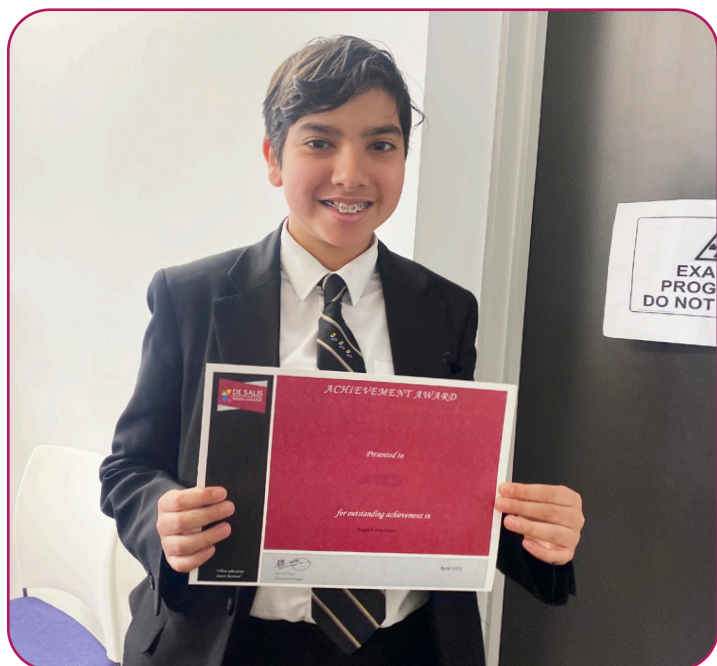


## Achievement Assembly
